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Course description

Fundamental English test focuses on basic English grammar, vocabulary and everyday life language patterns; reading for gist; and understand language used in classroom

Evaluation of Achievement

1. Examination 100%

Reading, structure, writing, oral exam

2. Class Participation

The students must attend the course not less than 80% (10 periods). They have to sign their names weekly by the first 15 minutes of each class or else they will be checked "absent".

In case of illness or accident, the students have to contact the section's lecturer to ask for an extra homework/task. Medical certificates or other evidences are also required.

In case of personal leave, the students have to let the section's lecturer known in advance and ask for the extra homework/task.

Tentative Grading Policy

1. The grading will be fixed rate (≥ 40 get an S, < 40 get a U) or other policy as the General Education Board agrees.
2. If students miss any of the score components (class attendance, and examination), he or she would automatically get a U.
3. The students who must be absent from the examination must inform the course coordinator in advance or by the examination day and provide the evidence of his/her absence (e.g. medical certification) as soon as possible. You can contact the course coordinator by yourself (via meeting face-to-face, telephone, or email) or ask your friend or family member to do so. Or else he or she would not get the make-up examination.
