Course Project for EFL60-206 Introduction to Academic Discussion

Students are required to conduct a course project. It is due during weeks 11 and 12, October 7 – October 20.

Specifications

- 1) Each group should have 3-5 students.
- 2) The project should reflect the students' understanding of the topic they have chosen.
- 3) The project's theme should be related to themes covered in the coursebook.
- 4) The language and presentation skills learned in the course must be applied.
- 5) The presentation must be conducted in English. Any non-English parts must have English subtitles.
- 6) The presentation should be original, and should involve all the group members.
- 7) Please try to keep it fun and interesting. You will be doing activities with the entire class, so be sure to keep everyone entertained and engaged.

Suggested projects

The project may cover any of the following suggested topics.

- 1) Changing shopping habits (style, online vs. B&M, brand vs. price)
- 2) Work/study habits in the digital age
- 3) Leisure time activities
- 4) Food, health, exercise
- 5) Innovation and the world in the future
- 6) TV shows and entertainment
- 7) Others, with approval

You must study, prepare, and rehearse in order to present the project within a good 15-20-minute session.

Format: Video presentation & classroom presentation and activities

Features: Original skit, presentation, interview, activities e.g. games, questionnaire & survey, role-play

Length: 15-20 minutes

Requirements: All students must speak English for at least 3 minutes each.

Points: 15% (60 points)
