This question paper consists of 100 multiple-choice questions and a writing session. They are divided into 3 parts: (130 minutes or 2 hours 10 minutes):

Part 1: Reading (Item 1 – 50)

Part 2: Listening (Item 51 –100)

Part 3: Writing

Test Format	Total Number of Questions
1. Listening consists of four parts:	
<input type="checkbox"/> Part 1: You will hear four statements about a picture, and then, you will select one statement that best describes what you see about the picture.	5
<input type="checkbox"/> Part 2: You will hear a question or statement and three responses spoken in English. Then, you will choose the best response to the question or statement.	15

Test Format	Total Number of Questions
<input type="checkbox"/> Part 3: You will hear some conversations between two people, and then, you will be asked to answer three questions about what the speakers say in each conversation.	15
<input type="checkbox"/> Part 4: You will hear some talks given by a single speaker, and then, you will be asked to answer three questions about what the speaker says in each talk.	15
2. Reading consists of three parts:	
<input type="checkbox"/> Part 1: You will complete sentences that miss a word or phrase.	20
<input type="checkbox"/> Part 2: You will complete an e-mail that misses a word or phrase.	5
<input type="checkbox"/> Part 3: You will read a selection of texts and choose the best answer for each question that follows each text.	25
3. Writing	
<input type="checkbox"/> You will choose one topic to respond to and write a short passage of at least 150 words to elaborate your response	1

The test includes 3 skills:

- Listening – 50 questions
- Reading – 50 questions
- Writing – 1 question

- Total time: 130 minutes (approximately 2 hours and 10 minutes)

The test scores will be used to place you into the appropriate English GEN courses.

For Semester 1/69, only the scores from the following 2 skills will be used for placement:

- Listening – 50 questions
- Reading – 50 questions

Total score: 50 points

- If you score 10 points or higher, you will receive a grade of S in GEN67-021.
- If you score less than 9.99 points, you will need to enroll in both GEN67-021 and GEN67-121

in Semester 1/69.

(If you pass, you don't need to take GEN67-021.)
